

What is it?

In-kind services support provided by

visit.brussels for the organisation of international professional events in Brussels.

Objectives:

- Promote the event internationally and locally
- •Boost the number of attendees & stakeholders
- •Enhance attendees' overall experience

How does it work?

- 1. Candidate fills in a request form
- Evaluation of the form carried out by the selection committee composed by: Innoviris, Hub Brussels, Febelux and visit.brussels
- 3. Official communication of eligibility
- Choice of the services to be delivered for a max. amount of 10 000€
- 5. Signature of the partnership agreement
- Delivery of the chosen in-kind services in the terms defined by the agreement

An honorary programme








It's a set of **activities**, **tools** and **support services** designed to assist individuals in attracting and organizing professional meetings in Brussels.
