Links between international organizations by frequency and by type: 2000

This table ranks organizations (whether intergovernmental or nongovernmental) according to the number of other organizations (whether intergovernmental or nongovernmental) they cite. Organizations have been divided into categories ranging from those which cite over 100 other organizations to those which cite no other organization.

They have further been divided into clusters of type. The types allocated to each clusters are as follows:

- Cluster I (International organizations): Types A B C D F
- Cluster II (Dependent organizations): Types E K R
- Cluster III (Organizational substitutes): Types S T
- Cluster IV (National organizations): Types G N
- Cluster V (Dead, inactive and unconfirmed bodies): Types H J U

For information on organization types, see the Appendix "Types of organization". For further detail on citations, see Figures in Section 3.

For example:

- Of the 10,910 organizations in Cluster I, 64 cite over 100 other organizations.
- Of the 5,985 organizations in Cluster II, 481 cite between 10 and 19 other organizations.
- In total, there are 53,841 organizations, of which 86 cite over 100 other organizations, while 23,844 cite no other organization.

Note that the total number of citations given in this table may differ from the totals given in other tables due to intervening editorial work.
