
Figure 10.1.1.14. International Olympic Committee (IOC)

Aims: Encourage the coordination, organization and development of sport and sports competitions; collaborate with the competent public and private organizations and authorities in the endeavour to place sport at the service of humanity; ensure the regular celebration of the Olympic Games; fight against any form of discrimination affecting the Olympic Movement; support and encourage the promotion of sports ethics; dedicate its efforts to ensuring that in sports the spirit of fair play prevails and violence is banned; lead the fight against doping in sport; take measures the goal of which is to prevent endangering the health of athletes; oppose any political or commercial abuse of sport and athletes; encourage the development of sport for all, which is part of the foundations of high-level sport, which in turn contributes to the development of sport for all; see to it that Olympic Games are held in conditions which demonstrate a responsible concern for environmental issues; support the International Olympic Academy (IOA); support other institutions which devote themselves to Olympic education.
