
Relations amongst international organizations concerned with human rights (A-F)

This image provides an unusual view of the set of 301 international organizations --limited to types A to F as being the most international. In this view the bodies have been positioned around the circumference of a central circle. Each body is denoted there by a smaller circle. The diameter of the smaller circles is in proportion to the number of links of that body (including to those not represented in this set). The unusual feature of this image is that many of the bodies have a diameter of approximately equal size -- which also has the effect of obscuring the less connected bodies. This is due to a constraint placed on the maximum size in any such image. In colour (see accompanying CD-ROM) the result is perhaps appropriately reminiscent of a flower. The links between the bodies are denoted by curves across the centre that emphasize the intensity of the interaction between such bodies.
