

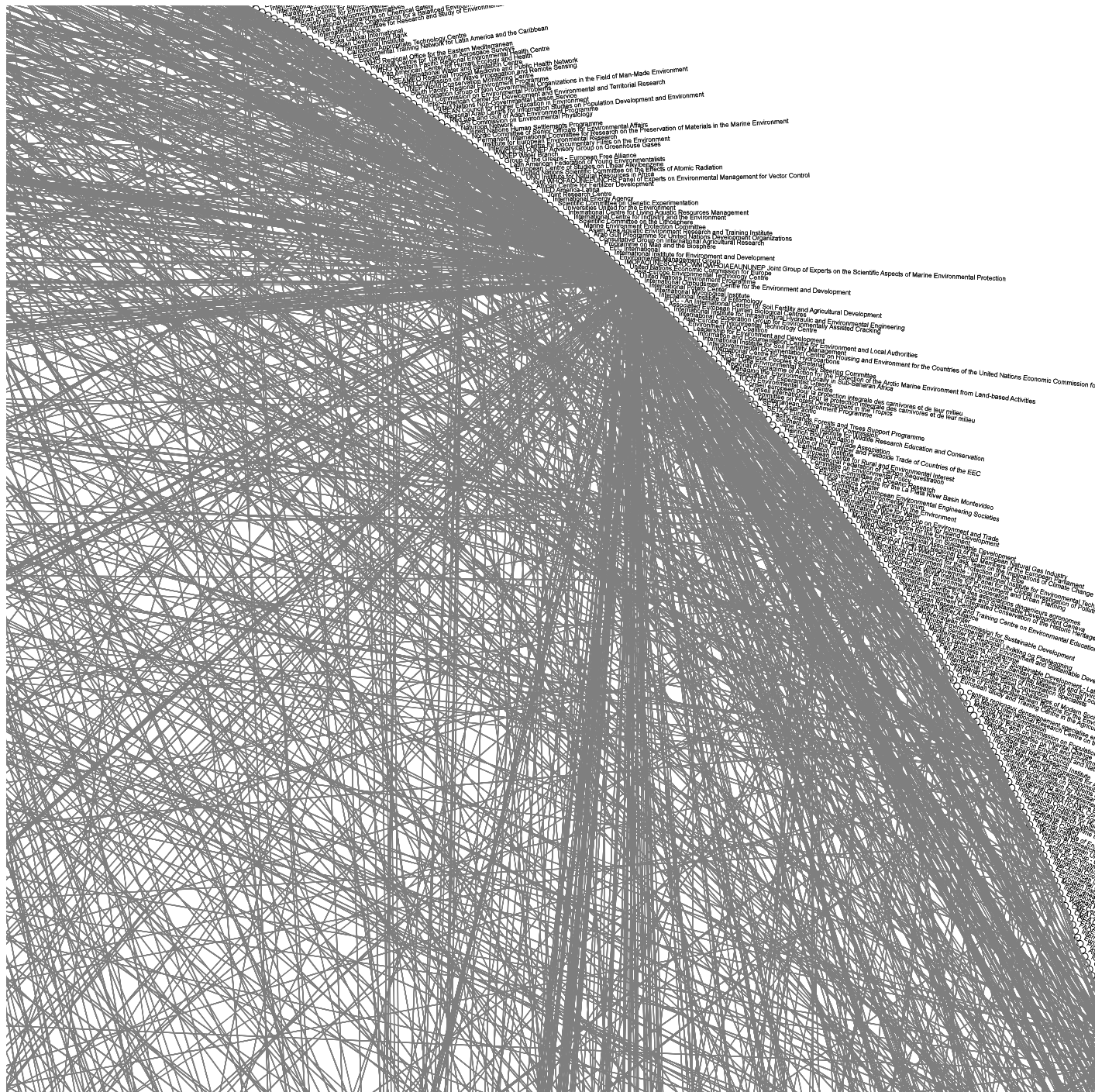
Figure 10.1.8. Relations amongst international organizations focusing on environment

This image is a segment of a larger circle representing the relations amongst 1644 international organizations concerned with the environment -- specifically mentioning it in their title. The bodies have been positioned around a circle with the titles just visible on the circumference. The relationships between them are represented by lines across the circle. The whole image, and the details of it, can be viewed on the accompanying CD-ROM by zooming out or in. The figure is an exercise in demonstrating the challenge of meaningfully coordinating the actions of the many bodies concerned with the environment whether through imposition of a global plan or through new insights into the processes of self-organization. The figure may be usefully compared with the separate figure concerned with the 296 strategies responding to "pollution".
