**Growth in link types of global strategies**

The top graph shows the growth in the number of links between global strategies, as profiled from documentation of international organizations and other constituencies. The types of relationships are (1) broader and narrower strategies; (2) related strategies; (3) strategies facilitating or facilitated by other strategies; and (4) strategies constraining or constrained by other strategies.

The second graph shows all links from the strategies database, both internal (as detailed in the top graph) and to other related databases. These are "bibliography", "world problems", "human values" and the "world wide web". Links to international organizations are present but too few relative to the others to be visible at this scale.

The pattern of growth is associated with work on the four successive editions of the *Encyclopedia of World Problems and Human Potential* and the subsequent web edition.
