
Figure 10.1.3.

Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations

Founded: 16 Oct 1945, Quebec. The Constitution of FAO was signed in 1945 by 44 countries. Absorbed International Institute of Agriculture set up as an intergovernmental organization on 7 June 1905, and International Emergency Food Council set up 1946. As a Specialized Agency of the United Nations Within United Nations System FAO reports annually to United Nations Economic and Social Council.

Aims: Contribute towards an expanding world economy and ensure humanity's freedom from hunger by: raising the level of nutrition and standard of living of people in member countries; securing improvement in the efficiency of production and distribution of all food and agricultural products; bettering the living conditions of rural populations.
