
## Figure 10.3.1. Providing health services

Maintaining public health and restoring sick people to good health by some medical - physical, chemical, emotional or psychic - means. Usually such services receive payment from the patient or from the patient's insurance company, although they may be government-financed or delivered by charities or volunteers. Health services require that a community develop a fundamental consensus on what constitutes being appropriately healthy. Consensus is also required about appropriate measures for maintaining health, especially as regards those measures which intrude upon strong social values.
