

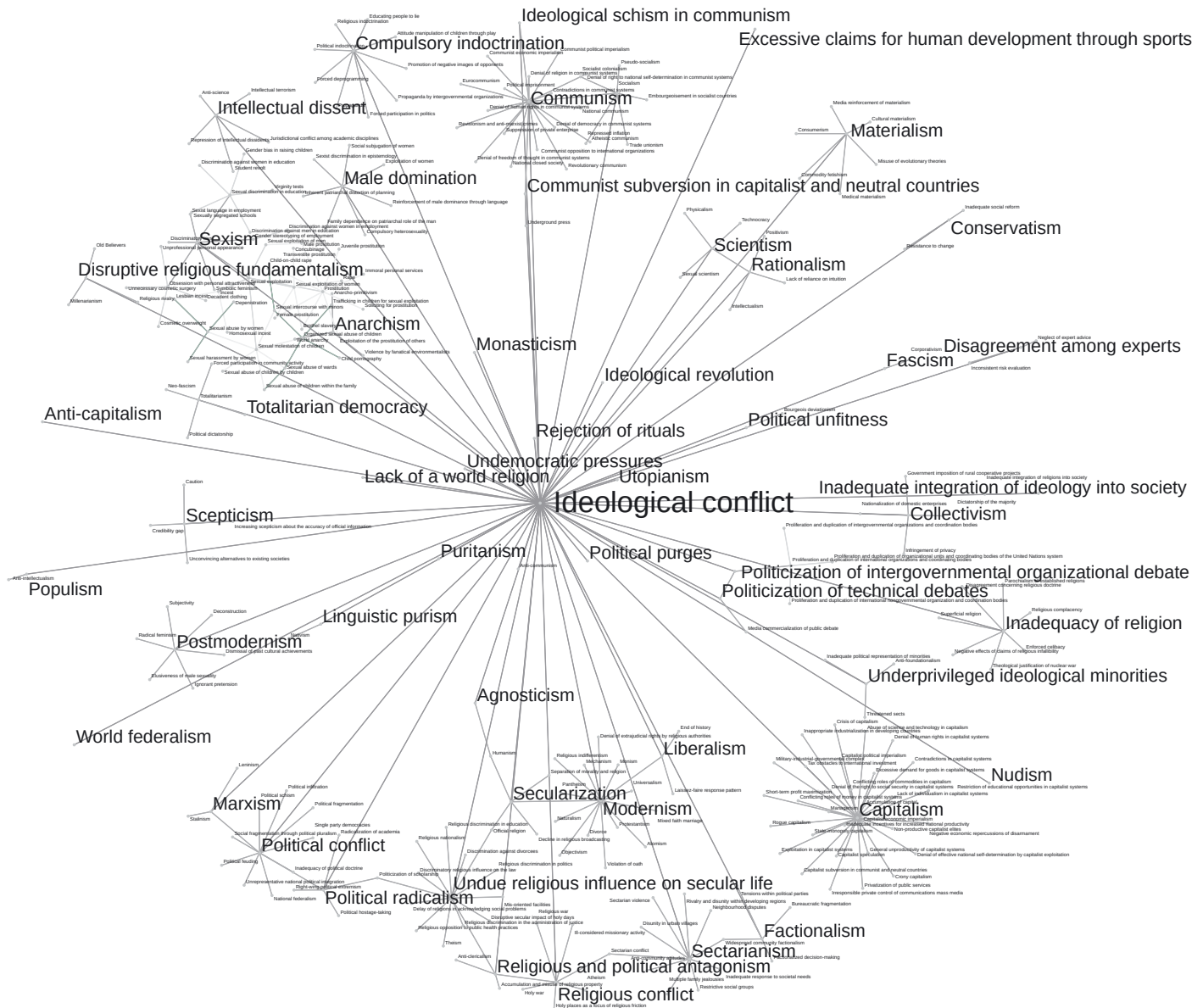
Figure 10.2.8. Ideological conflict
