
Figure 10.3.9.

Links amongst strategies focused on pollution

his image is a segment of a larger circle representing the relations amongst 296 strategies employed, or advocated, by international bodies in response to pollution - specifically mentioned in the main title attributed to that strategy. The strategies have been positioned around a circle with the titles visible on the circumference. The strategies are denoted by smaller circles of varying diameter (according to the number of links of any type that they have to other strategies, not necessarily those in the figure). The relationships between them are represented by lines across the circle. The whole image, and the details of it, can be viewed on the accompanying CD-ROM by zooming out or in. The figure is an exercise in demonstrating the challenge of meaningfully coordinating the strategies of the many bodies concerned with the environment -- whether through imposition of a global plan or through new insights into the processes of self-organization. The figure may be usefully compared with the separate figure concerned with the 1644 international bodies concerned with "environment".
