### **Leading people in international organizations – academic background: 2005**

These figures, reproduced from *Who' Who in International Organizations*, 5<sup>th</sup> edition, are based on the entries of the 2,986 biographees that contain information on educational background.

Breakdowns are given for male and female biographees; however, because gender is not always known to the editors, the figures given in the columns "Both" may be greater than the sum of the columns "Men" and "Women". The tables also give the total number of organizations (from the *Yearbook of International Organizations*) listed in the entries of these biographees.

It should be noted that the figures in these tables are derived from information provided by the biographees themselves; according to general policy, the editors took people at their word and made no effort to check the accuracy of the claims.

#### **Figure 6.2.2 (a) Academic degrees**

This table gives the number of biographees claiming to hold an academic degree of one of the specified types. Note that this table indicates only that a given number of biographees claims *at least* the degree specified; these biographees may claim other degrees as well. The totals given are not exclusive: a biographee claiming two or more of the types of degree listed here will have been counted in the totals for each one of the degrees he or she claims.

It should also be noted that the information listed in the "Education" paragraph is not exhaustive. For example, a biographee may have specified only that she holds a doctoral degree and is therefore included here only in the total of "Doctorate"; while it is highly probable that she holds an undergraduate degree as well, she is not included in the total of "Bachelor" because that information is not listed in her "Education" paragraph.

The headings in this table are standardized and simplified: the totals include various types, in various languages, of comparable levels of academic distinction. The heading "unspecified" is used in cases where the biographee refers only to being a "graduate of" or to holding a "degree from" an institution of higher education.

#### **Figure 6.2.2 (b) Combinations of academic degrees**

This table gives the number of biographees claiming to hold two of any of the above degrees. Note that this table indicates only that a given number of biographees claims *at least* the two degrees specified; these biographees may claim other degrees as well. The totals given are not exclusive: a biographee claiming three or more of the types of degree listed here will have been counted in the totals for each combination of the degrees he or she claims.

It should also be noted that the information listed in the "Education" paragraph is not exhaustive. For example, a biographee may have specified that she holds a masters and a doctoral degree and is therefore included here only in the total of "Master + Doctorate"; while it is highly probable that she holds an undergraduate degree as well, she is not included in the total of "Bachelor + Master" because that information is not listed in her "Education" paragraph.

The headings in this table are standardized and simplified: the totals include various types, in various languages, of comparable levels of academic distinction. The heading "unspecified" is used in cases where the biographee refers only to being a "graduate of" or to holding a "degree from" an institution of higher education.

### Figure 6.2.2. (c). Location of institutions of higher education

Ten or more biographees are listed as having attended an institution of higher education in the following 87 locations (cities, states, countries, regions, etc.). The name chosen to identify a location is generally linked to the name(s) of the institution(s) located there.

Many of the locations listed here cover more than one institution of higher education; in principle, the totals given include all biographees whose "Education" paragraph indicates they have attended at least of those institutions. For example, the total for "London" includes biographees who have attended the University of London, the London School of Economics, the London School of Oriental Studies, etc; the total for "Paris" includes the University of Paris under various names (Paris X, Sorbonne, etc.), the Institut d'études politiques de Paris, the Institut catholique de Paris, etc.

The totals given are not exclusive: a biographer who has attended institutions of higher education in different locations will have been counted in the totals for each location.
