These charts show, for each continental grouping, the distribution of secretariats of international organizations (whether intergovernmental or nongovernmental) for the cities in which are located principal and secondary offices.

The organization types allocated to each cluster are as follows:

Cluster I (International organizations): Types A B C D F

Cluster II (Dependent organizations): Types E K R



Cluster III (Organizational substitutes): Types S T

Cluster IV (National organizations): Types G N


Cluster V (Dead, inactive and unconfirmed bodies): Types H J U

Note that graph scales vary.


