This figure is based on the entries of the 1,843 biographees that contain information on language proficiency. In these entries 130 languages are mentioned; these 130 languages are listed in Table 4. Of these 130 languages, 49 are listed by only 1 biographee while 44 are listed by more than 4 biographees; these 44 languages are listed in Table 5.

This figure gives the number of biographees indicating a proficiency in one or more languages. For example, 476 biographees claim to be bi-lingual and 367 claim to be tri-lingual; 3 biographees profess proficiency in 10 languages, 1 in 11 languages.

It should be noted that the figures in these tables are derived from information provided by the biographees themselves; according to general policy, the editors took people at their word and made no effort to check the accuracy of the claims.
