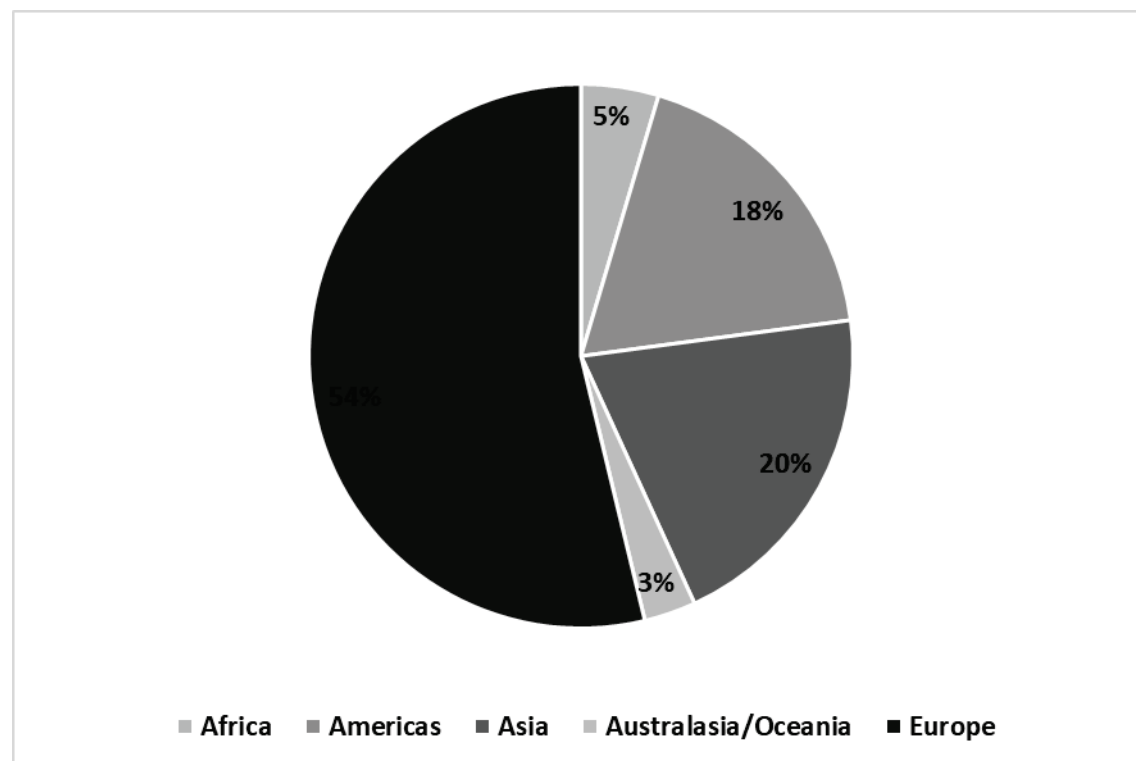

2.3 Meetings by continent

2.3.1 Continental division in the past 20 years

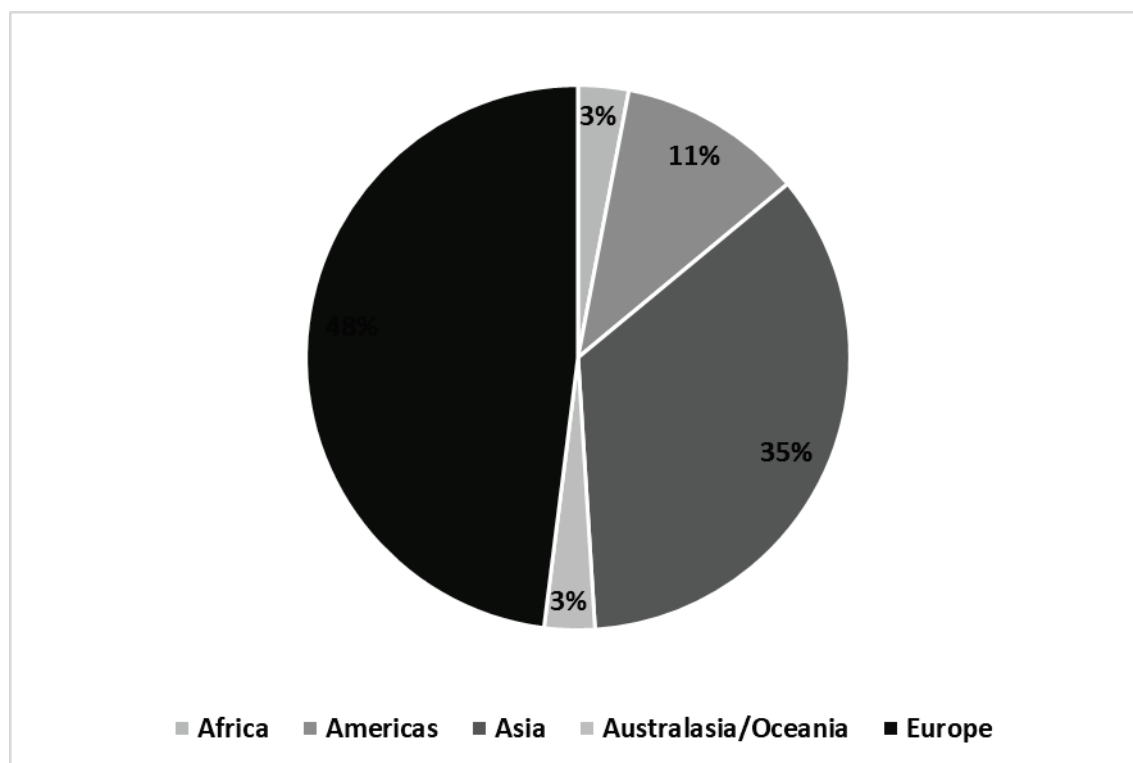
This chart shows how the international association meetings of Type “A” held from 1999 to 2018 are spread over the continents.*
